

# **DISSCO**® CSS1h TACK COAT

## CSS1h EMULSIFIED ASPHALT

#### DESCRIPTION

DISSCO CSS1h Tack Coat is a cationic slow setting emulsified asphalt designed to provide adhesion for asphalt patches to existing asphalt pavement, brick or concrete. DISSCO Tack Coat waterproofs the edges of the patch to prevent water intrusion through the joint, and helps prevent pushing and shoving of the patching material by rolling. DISSCO Tack Coat is environmentally friendly containing no solvents.

## SURFACE PREPARATION

Surface to be tacked should be clean and dry. Remove dirt and debris by hand or mechanical sweeping or with a high-volume blower to remove dirt, loose rock and vegetation.

## **APPLICATION**

**DISSCO** CSS1h Tack Coat is supplied in a concentrate form and may be used directly from the container. Applicator may choose to thin with water prior to use up to a one to one or two to on ratio to ease application and or to decrease brake time. Apply with a brush, broom, roller or spray equipment. Thin overlays should have an 8" wide band around the perimeter of the patch and apply at a rate of .06 to.10 gal/sq. yd. in the center areas. On excavated or utility patch repairs all vertical surfaces of existing pavement should be coated. *Do not apply when rain is imminent or when surface to be coated or surface and/or ambient air temperature is below 32°F (0°C)*.

## **CURE TIME**

Cure time will vary depending on weather conditions. Product will appear brown in color after applied. Apply patch material once tack coat has turned black.

## **STORAGE**

**DISSCO** Tack Coat may be stored outdoors when ambient air temperatures are above 40°F (4°C). DISSCO Tack Coat is water base and will freeze. *KEEP FROM FREEZING*. Clean tools with water immediately after use.

#### **CLEAN UP**

Rinse tools with water immediately after use. If tack coat has dried, clean with mineral spirits or a good citrus-based degreaser.
